We received some not so good news earlier this month. Our application funding for our new building was declined NZ Lotteries. They informed us that applications of \$22,852,126 were received but they only had enough funds to pay out on \$9,041,292.

Our team, who have worked extremely hard, and spent many hours on this, are all extremely disappointed. We do want to reassure you all however that this has most definitely not affected our resolve, we remain very positive and will keep moving forward.

In fact the very night after we received this news, our build team met, have refocused and already started working on other options for funding our new building.
