Parents, thank you in advance for supporting your child and to commit to the working hours for them.





COACH PROFILE: PASHA LEVCHENKO

Head Coach, Mens Artistic Gymnastics (MAG)

I joined Hutt Valley Gymnastics in June 2016 relocating with my family from Spain. I am known as Pavel (in Soviet Union), Pavlo (in Ukraine) and shorted to Pasha for everyone who knows me. I was born and grew up in Ukraine.

I firstly discovered gymnastics when I was 4-yrs old while visiting the circus. I asked my parents if I could do gym as I was excited about what I saw. We visited the gymnastics club and I was invited to join but my parents didn't sign me up in time. But it was meant to be as by Christmas, the coach came to my Kindy and picked gymnastics boys. She chose me and one other boy inviting us to join. When my Mum came to collect me I told her that "as she hadn't taken me to gym - they had come to collect me". This was the start of my gymnastics journey.

I was a competitive gymnast from 5-18 years. At 12 I was chosen to be on the Olympic pathway. Unfortunately I didn't fulfil my dream of being an Olympic Gymnast and finished as a Junior FIG level (FIG, International Federation of Gymnastics). I was proud to represent Ukraine at the Stella Zakharova Cup; International Competition. My Olympic goals continue, although now from a coaching perspective.

The situation in Ukraine was not good and I chose to study aviation at University, in an effort to leave the country. Then I decided to travel around the World as a dancer and acrobat performer. This experience of different cultures and countries helped me develop an open-minded attitude; taking on the many ways to do things and being able to teach them. I am always open to new ideas and ways to improve and keep growing as an individual. I am fluent in five languages and understand several others.

Over the time I realised that dancing was not something I would do all my life. I decided to return to gymnastics and become a Coach. Firstly, in Ukraine and then moving to Spain. All my coaching studies were completed in Spain and I am qualified as a FIG Level 2 Coach. This qualification automatically granted me NZ Senior Coach for MAG and WAG status. I am also a Senior Advanced MAG Judge.

In Spain I have coached MAG and WAG and have had girls going to Worlds. Two of my boys joined the Olympic Centre in Madrid. I also coached my son Nicolas (Nico) until he turned 14.

I am very focused on the development of MAG within our region and my goal is to grow a high-performance MAG Squad, and a winning Olympian! I really like the MAG community around New Zealand, all helping each other and working together.
